**Day 1 ~ Arrive Rome:** You'll be met coming out of baggage claims and passport control by your driver holding a sign with your name on it for your private transfer from Rome Fiumicino airport to your hotel in central Rome for three night's accommodations. (*Transfers do not include portage or assistance. Limit: One suitcase and one handbag allowed per person. Accommodation, Rome*)

**Day 2 ~ Rome:** After breakfast, you have a morning city tour. (*Breakfast, accommodation, Rome*)

- Meet your **Classic Rome Tour** between 8:00 and 8:40 a.m. in your hotel lobby (specific pick-up time will be in your documents). Tour includes walking visits to Trevi Fountain, a visit to Vatican City and St. Peter's Square and Basilica to see Michelangelo's Pieta and more, with return to area of your hotel. (*Entrance to St Peter's or other churches requires appropriate attire - no shorts, miniskirts or uncovered shoulders. Sundays and holidays: On-own visit inside of St Peter's Basilica is not possible.*)
- Tonight you dine at **El Toulà** with reservations at 8:00 p.m. to experience fine traditional cuisine of El Toulà (*right*) served in small, discrete rooms. (*Arrive on your own for a 3-course dinner with 1/2 bottle of mineral water and 1/2 bottle of house wine per person, gratuities not included. Please present voucher before ordering.*)

**Day 3 ~ Rome:** After breakfast, you have this day at leisure, or you can choose from a number of optional Avanti tours and excursions such as the **Vatican Museums Half Day** tour or the **Naples ~ Pompeii Full Day Tour with Lunch**. (*Breakfast, accommodation, Rome.*)



- **Optional Vatican Museums Half Day Tour** Via motorcoach to the Vatican with admission tickets to the Museums to experience Michelangelo's frescos in the Sistine Chapel as well as other galleries and even some papal rooms. (*Daily at 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., guided tour lasts 3 hours with hotel pick-up and return with option to return on your own for additional time in museums.*)

**Day 4 ~ Rome to Amalfi Coast:** After breakfast, meet your driver for your transfer to the rail station for your transportation to Naples by 1<sup>st</sup> class rail with seat reservations aboard Italy's premier train. *(Breakfast, Rome; Accommodation, Sorrento)*

You will be met on the platform of Naples Centrale rail station by your driver for your private transfer to Sorrento with a 2 hour visit of the ruins of Pompeii. *(Meals, entrance to Pompeii and gratuities not included.)*



- **Ruins of Pompeii private tour** Pompeii (left) was Roman city destroyed by a two-day long eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 A.D. Along with neighboring Herculaneum, Pompeii remained buried under 60 feet of ash until being discovered in 1748. Today Pompeii is one of the most popular tourist sites in Italy, and is a UNESCO World Heritage Site<sup>1</sup>.

**Day 5 ~ Sorrento:** After breakfast, explore this quaint, charming and walk-able town, but don't forget your dinner reservations tonight. *(Breakfast & Accommodation, Sorrento)*

- Arrive on your own for dinner at **Ristorante Tasso** with reservations at 8:00 p.m. This charming Sorrento restaurant features pizza cooked in a traditional Italian wood-burning oven. *(Present voucher prior to ordering. Includes one 3-course dinner per person, beverage and gratuities not included.)*
