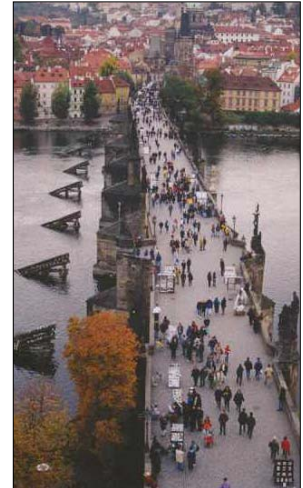


Prague & Bratislava

7 Days / 6 Nights

Recommended Vacation Package (RVP)
(Note: Itinerary can be planned in either order)



Explore the highlights of Prague, from the Charles Bridge (above & right) to Old Town Square, then continue to Bratislava by rail and enjoy museums, culture and monuments.

Day 1 ~ Prague: Arrive in Prague and meet your driver for your private transfer to your hotel.
(Accommodation, Prague) *Note: Transfers do not include portage or assistance. Limit: One suitcase and one handbag allowed per person.*

Day 2 ~ Prague: After breakfast, meet your tour in the hotel lobby. After your tour you have the day to yourself for exploration and relaxation. (Breakfast & accommodation, Prague)



- **Grand City Tour** Your grand excursion starts along the Vltava River past Manes Palace, Zofin Palace and the National Theatre, with a visit of Prague Castle with a guided courtyard walk. Then a visit to the historic Charles Bridge before crossing the river to the Hradčany district (*left*) with a guided walk to visit Loretto Church, the Royal Palace, St. Vitus Cathedral, St. George Church and Golden Lane. Your tour ends with a visit of Old Town Square, Nicholas Church and the Astronomical Clock. (Tour begins at 9:30 a.m. and lasts 3½ hours with hotel pick up. Clients at K+K Central arrive on-their-own to Republic Square in Old Town.)

- **Dinner at U Karlova Mostu Restaurant** Arrive on your own for your 8:00 p.m. reservations at this traditional restaurant with an interesting interior and unique menu located at Karlova Most (Charles Bridge). This old-time Czech brasserie features good beer, classic Czech cuisine and unforgettable historic atmosphere and gives you a choice of three menus. (Please present your voucher prior to ordering. Includes a 3-course dinner, beverages and gratuities not included.)



Day 3 ~ Prague: After breakfast you have the day free to explore, or you may elect to take an optional tour. *(Breakfast & accommodation, Prague)*

Optional Sightseeing

- **Prague Castle with admission** Daily at 11:30 a.m., lasts 3 ½ hours, arrive on your own to starting point.
- **Cesky Krumlov with lunch** Daily at 9:00 a.m., lasts 10 hours with hotel pick-up.

Day 4 ~ Prague to Bratislava: After breakfast, arrive on your own for your transportation by 1st class rail to Bratislava. *(Breakfast, Vienna;*

Day 5 ~ Bratislava: Arrive in Bratislava, optional transfers are available to your hotel. Today Bratislava is one of the most rapidly growing urban regions of Europe, a mixing pot of nationalities who live together in peace and harmony. There is a saying that a true 'Pressburgian' speaks four languages: Slovak, German, Hungarian and Mishmash *(two words in German, two in Hungarian and two in Slovak - all in one sentence)*. *(Breakfast & accommodation, Bratislava)*



Devin Castle

- **Private Bratislava City Tour** Meet your guide in your hotel lobby for your 3-hour tour. You visit Bratislava Castle then visit the famous Devin Castle *(with admission)*. A romantic ruin ever since it was blown up by Napoleon's army in 1809, Devin's Castle offers breath taking views of neighboring Austria and on a clear day the Alps. Next you tour on foot the Presidential Palace, Government Palace, Opera House, Main Square, Old Town Hall, St. Michael's Gate and Primate Palace *(with admission)* before returning to your hotel.

- **Dinner at Reštaurácia Koliba-Expo in Kamzik** Arrive on your own for your 8:00 p.m. reservation for a 3-course dinner featuring authentic Slovak cuisine including fresh fish, local meats and game, and produce prepared using traditional mouth-watering recipes. *(Please present your voucher prior to ordering; beverages and gratuities not included.)*



Day 6 ~ Bratislava: After breakfast you have the day free to explore at your leisure, or consider an optional tour. *(Breakfast & accommodation, Bratislava)*

Optional Tours

- **Bratislava Bridges by Boat** A panoramic cruise on the Danube River with narration in English under the bridges of Bratislava bridges with extraordinary view of the city. *(Operates daily, lasts 45 minutes.)*
- **Traditional Slovak Folk Dinner** Enjoy a traditional Slovak home-made meal in an authentic cottage with live music and show and a private English-speaking guide.

Day 7 ~ Depart Bratislava: After breakfast at your hotel, you're ready to depart on your next Avanti destination. *(Breakfast, Bratislava)*
