Relax and people watch in the charming sidewalk cafes of the *Boulevard St. Germain*. The hotels we offer in Paris are found on your choice of the Left or the Right Bank and are primarily quaint and boutique for an authentic French experience, yet are available in three, four or five star ratings.

- Your Visite Pass is the best way to get around Paris without fighting the traffic. Included in your Avanti Destinations package, a Visite Pass is good for unlimited travel on the Metro subway and surface buses in Paris for either zones 1-3 or 1-5. A Zones 1-3 pass takes you to 95% of the Paris sights most travelers wish to see.



- You can start your Les Car Rouges Hop-on Hop-off Tour anytime from 9:30 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. at any of nine stops from Place Trocadero, Champs de Mars, Musee du Louvre, Notre Dame, Musee d Orsay, Opera Garnier or the Grand Palais. Of course, you can “hop-on” or “hop-off” for two full days. Recorded commentary is available in several languages including English. Personal headsets are available.

Suggested Optional Paris Tours ~

- **Dinner at Eiffel Tower, Seine Cruise + Illuminations** Daily at 6:30 p.m. with hotel pick up, lasts 5½ hours. Start with a cruise passing the 32 illuminated bridges, then to dinner at Altitude 95 on the 1st floor of the Eiffel Tower for a 3-course dinner with beverages – and your choice of entrée. After, you see Paris on a night tour in a minibus before return to your hotel.
- **D-Day Landing Beaches in Normandy via minibus with lunch** Operates Monday, Wednesday and Saturday, lasts 12 hours, with hotel pick up and return in an air-conditioned 8-passenger mini-bus A day dedicated to the heroes of WWII with visits in the charming Normandy region famous for producing cider, calvados liquor, the unrivalled Camembert cheese and historical medieval cities.

About the Eurostar & the Eurotunnel

What people call the “chunnel” is really the **Eurotunnel** through which freight and passenger trains travel under the English Channel between England and France. Service through the Eurotunnel is by high-speed **Eurostar** train connecting downtown London and downtown Paris with fast, safe and frequent service. Your trip takes 2 hours 20 minutes with only 20 minutes under the Channel. Eurostar trains are comfortable and modern with dining cars and snack service at your seat. *Best of all, Avanti makes your rail travel arrangements for you directly with Rail Europe for your complete convenience.*
