

Scotland Whisky Trail

No fewer than half of Scotland's malt distilleries are in Speyside in North Scotland's "Malt Whisky Country". On your Whisky Trail tour, you drive through this landscape of redstone cliffs and sandy beaches to the village of Granttown-on-Spey at the junction of the rivers Lour and Spey where the water of the Cairngorms is a prime ingredient in the national beverage distilled here.

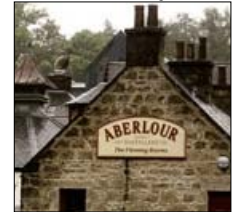

Day 1 ~ Drive to Granttown-on-Spey: Pick up your rental car at a location convenient to your plans, and drive to this delightful village in the Speyside Valley and the Whisky Road. (*Accommodation, Granttown-on-Spey*)

- **Malt Whisky Map of Scotland** A full color presentation of the whisky-producing regions of Scotland with a black-and-white Victorian map on the reverse, with regional tasting notes along with indexes, website addresses and other material of interest to the connoisseur including profiles of Scotland's top distilleries.

Day 2 ~ Granttown-on-Spey: After breakfast, you visit the Aberlour Distillery for a tour and tasting. The rest of your day is at leisure to explore this peaceful valley or you may wish to visit other whisky distilleries in the area. (*Breakfast & accommodation, Granttown-on-Spey*)

- You will be booked on the 10:30 tour at Aberlour Distillery. This in-depth tour shows you the whisky making process first hand followed by a tutored tasting session. Highlights include a leisurely sampling of Aberlour whiskies and the opportunity to hand-fill a personalized bottle of an exclusive single malt - something no lover of Scotch whisky should miss. (*Distillery tour lasts just under 2 hours and is conducted in small groups. You must be of legal drinking age in your country of residence to visit Aberlour Distillery.*)



Day 3 ~ Depart Granttown-on-Spey: Depart after breakfast for home or your next Avanti Destinations experience. (*Breakfast, Granttown-on-Spey*)
