Documentation Requirements:

US Citizens: Passport is required. Visa is not required for stays of 3 months or less. Persons other than US citizens should check directly with the Greek Consulate. In addition, persons visiting Greece must be able to show they have sufficient funds, roundtrip or onward ticket.
