## CAIRO:

## CAIRO:

Visit the citadel of Salah El Din, a medieval Islamic-era fortification preserved as a World Heritage Site and one of Cairo's main attractions. Inside the citadel, you will visit the impressive Mohamed Ali mosque, named after Mohamed Ali Pasha, the 19th-century Ottoman ruler of Egypt. After exploring these sites, your guide will take you to absorb the colors and aromas of the famous bazaar of Khan El Khalili in the heart of Cairo. Here you will have an opportunity to barter for souvenirs and enjoy the local custom of drinking mint tea while you shop.

## LUXOR:

After breakfast, meet your driver for a private transfer for your flight to Luxor. Spread out on the east bank of the Nile, Luxor is the tourist Mecca of the Nile Valley.
