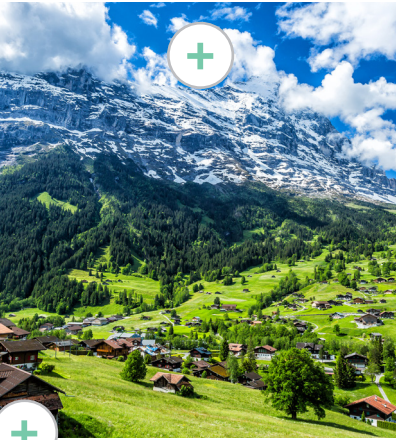

Passes vs. Point-to-Point (PTP)

Passes allow for extensive travel for a specific duration on the indicated rail network. If seat reservations are required there will be an additional supplement, starting at approximately \$12.00 per passenger, per train.

Example: an Austria/Germany Eurail Two Country Select Pass for 4 days within 2 months will allow the pass holder extensive travel in Austria and Germany for any 4 days within 2 months from the date of pass activation.

Point-to-Point (PTP) is an individual ticket issued for a specific route, date and time.

Example: a Eurostar ticket indicating TGT9023-PARIS NORD-LONDON ST PANCRAS-11:13-12:39 will be a one-time-use ticket for that specific train number, route, date and time indicated on the ticket.

PTP Ticket Types

Open Ticket — common on regional routes, valid for passage on any train along the ticketed route, seating is open and cannot be reserved (this ticket type may require validation prior to boarding the train).

Open Ticket, seat reservation optional — a separate reservation may be purchased for a specific seat on a specific train, however it is not required (Avanti Destinations provides our clients with seat reservations whenever possible).

Open Ticket, seat reservation required — a separate reservation must be purchased for a specific seat on a specific train (a fine will be assessed on board if seat reservations are not pre-purchased when required).

Ticket + Seat Reservation combined — common on Premier and High-Speed trains, this ticket type will automatically include a seat reservation when issued (all Print-At-Home e-tickets and Avanti voucher tickets will be this type).
