Within a city, this includes using the metro or bus system for sightseeing with your private guide. For a day trip, utilize the high-speed train to maximize your time in the destination.





Standing over ground zero of the 1945 atomic bomb blast, the Peace Memorial Park is dedicated to all the victims of that fateful event. It serves as a poignant reminder of the horrors of nuclear war.



For first-time visitors to Japan, staying in a ryokan — a traditional Japanese inn — is one of the best ways to get introduced to the country's ancient culture. Typical features like tatamimatted rooms, futon bedding, access to onsen (hot spring baths), and inclusive meals make for a truly unforgettable experience. The tatami flooring's slight grassy fragrance enhances the sensory appeal of the already interesting old-style lodging.

Unlike western-style accommodations, a ryokan stay is about minimalist luxury that puts a premium on space, simplicity, and peace of mind. The Japanese generally prefer understated style choices achieved by avoiding bulky furniture and using the same space for multiple purposes. For example, you'll notice right away there

isn't a bedroom – at least not in the western sense of the word.

The meals alone are worth looking forward to. Kaiseki dining is rooted on the Japanese principle of shun – choosing ingredients at the peak of their freshness – then displaying each one to show their unique natural beauty. This results in perfect harmony between delicious cuisine and artistic expression. Each meal features a set menu that is typically chosen to highlight a specific seasonal theme. An example might be a budding sakura — a fully bloomed cherry blossom — to represent Spring.

After a traditional kaiseki meal, the ryokan staff will remove the dinner table, replacing it with comfortable futons to enable you to wind down for the evening. The transformation is

elegant and well-practiced. There are other arrangements available as well, for those who prefer a more westernstyle bedding.

I always find that a visit to the public onsen is the perfect way to relax during the day. Allowing the warmth and natural minerals of the hot spring wash the daily stress away is a spiritually cleansing moment for some, though I would strongly suggest that travelers do a little research about the general guidelines and proper etiquette before visiting one.

It's easy to see how a ryokan stay is the ideal way to immerse yourself in Japanese culture. Every time I return home after staying in one, I always find myself at ease with less-cluttered thoughts, something that I think everyone could use a little more of.



Transcending any categorization, Tokyo is a city of incredible diversity, captivating anyone eager to wander. From the neon-illuminated streets along imposing skyscrapers, one quick turn could lead you to an entirely different world.

Narrow streets lure passersby with inviting flavors, ancient temples hidden just behind bustling corners, and the beauty of cherry blossom trees bloom in traditional gardens. Wherever you may choose to venture, Japan's dynamic capital will surely amaze.

The past and future thrive simultaneously in South Korea. During my trip I witnessed high-tech trains zip beneath streets that were littered with old markets and Buddhist temples. Instead of clashing against each other, the country's past and present coexist harmoniously. But as much as I adored this beautiful duality, my favorite parts of the journey were my experiences outside of Seoul.

I visited Andong Hahoe Folk Village, a place whose name literally translates as 'village surrounded by water'. Fitting, considering the Nakdong River cocoons the entire community. The view from the top of Buyongdae Cliff was what struck me the most. Looking down at the aged houses nestled together, protected by the dramatic cliffs and rivers on all sides, I realized that I was staring at a perfectly maintained glimpse of the country's historical past.

A simple two-hour drive west from Hahoe is a charming community of Hanok houses. Hanoks — traditional Korean houses — were first built in the 14th century, and there are still over 800 well-preserved structures in Jeonju's Hanok Village. I imagined that every home would look the same, but that wasn't the case. While a triangular tiled roof was uniformly laid atop all the houses, each one stood out with their own unique character. Some showcased stone, others had elaborate wood carvings, while a few exuded graces minus the extra flair.

I was fortunate enough to stay in a few historical accommodations like a hanok and a Korean Buddhist temple for a night. They really do provide you with a completely immersive cultural experience. There was one point when I woke up to the sound of Monks beating on Dharma drums, the noise permeating the morning air with a soothing rhythm.

South Korea has beautifully mastered the balancing act of giving honor to their past, while pushing forward towards the future. The futuristic technology and modern lifestyles are encouraged but there is always time during the day to practice simplicity and contemplation. Since my return I find even during the chaos that can overtake my life, it's important to remember what I learned on my trip; "Don't let your thoughts and opinions cloud the beauty around you".



Surrounded by rice fields and lush bamboo forests along the river's edge, it was a truly magnificent view.

I once spent a while in Tibet - a tranquil place where it's easy to lose track of time. For hundreds of years, the monks of Tibet have imparted their priceless wisdom about the joys of silence and the rewards of contemplation. It's remarkable to think that there were still monasteries that housed hundreds of monks at any given time; places where they spun their prayer wheels and chanted sutras while walking along Barkor Street beside Jokhang Temple — one of the holiest temples in Tibetan Buddhism.

I've been to this country several times in my life, but this Tibetan trip provided me with a brand-new set of adventures and ideas to ponder upon. 





In my recent travels over the past few years, I have constantly yearned for a trip that would satisfy both my wanderlust and my increasing thirst for new, fun, and heartwarming experiences. So when I was presented with the wonderful opportunity to go to Chengdu and observe the incredibly adorable Chinese Giant Panda in its natural habitat, I immediately packed my bags without hesitation.

The China Conservation and Research Center for the Giant Panda sits on eight square miles of lush bamboo forest. The area's climate and the surrounding vegetation are ideally suited to the needs of the famously fluffy creatures.

I spent the day as a volunteer at the center, where I learned more about the

previously endangered species and the efforts to further increase their population. The best part of being there though, to be honest, was watching the pandas go about their lazy lives in the cutest ways possible.

Although I've always wanted to see the Giant Pandas up close, they weren't the only reason I was excited to visit Chengdu. I've read about the Sanxingdui Ruins — recognized as one of the most important archaeological remains in the world — and I promised myself that I would visit it someday.

Though the site itself was first discovered by a farmer in 1929, two major sacrificial pits were discovered in 1986. The pits spurred the attention of academic experts from all over the

world, mainly due to the fact that almost nothing is known about them. No physical evidence about the people who lived there or what happened to them has ever been found. Needless to say, seeing such a fascinating and mysterious part of ancient history with my own two eyes was quite moving.

In the end, my visit to Chengdu provided me with a great mix of hilarious, uplifting, and wondrous memories. It was the type of trip that ended even better than I was expecting, making it an experience I will always remember.

Bao, I was eager to try them out for the first time; and it definitely did not disappoint! Our table held a variety of dumpling types, but I have to say that the spicier ones were my favorite. I also learned the correct way to eat Xiao Long Bao. Here's a hint: pierce a hole in the dumplings first before sucking the juices out in order to avoid burning your mouth.

We really had a great time despite the short duration of our stay, which made me realize that Taiwan is as perfect a place for a stopover as any other renowned port country in the region. To this day, about one-third of Mongolia's population is fully nomadic with many Mongolians unwilling to settle down. They call the boundless steppes and seemingly inhospitable Gobi Desert their home.

#### **AVANTI INSIGHT**

The picturesque beauty of Halong Bay is widely known. Most people opt for a 1-night cruise which provides a great look at the limestone islands, but can be crowded with boats. With a 2-night cruise, you'll have a full day to explore the bay further away from the day trippers and closer to nature.







Embarking on a Halong Bay cruise was easily one of my best travel decisions ever. I'd never spent a night out at sea, so I was a bit anxious at first. The ship itself was familiar both in its interior and in its bright traditional sails that guided it smoothly through the bay. Fortunately, the transfer from Hanoi was surprisingly calming, setting the tone for the rest of the unforgettable trip.

Having western-styled sleeping and dining options was a nice familiarity when everything else around me felt new and different. In no time, I was signing up for exotic excursions and tasting food I'd never tried before. By the end of the cruise I was trying to fit in as much as I could.

I can't explain how I felt after exploring Halong Bay. I never thought I would stand witness to a place that's so beautifully unreal. I've traveled around the world, but I've never seen anything so otherworldly as the archipelago's 1,600 natural limestone islands. They towered over me, but instead of feeling overwhelmed, I felt at peace with nature. The scenic seascape simply washed away whatever was left of my anxieties.

I wasn't the only one with those sentiments; a quick look around our dining room proved that. Whispers and laughter mingled with the sound of silverware and clinking glasses as our collective noise filled those otherwisequiet candlelit evenings. Deadlines and due dates felt like distant memories that dissipated into the night sky.

Every moment of that 2-night cruise made me feel like that. I kayaked my way around the islands and explored their grottos. I tried a Vietnamese cooking class, which was great since I enjoy cooking at home and trying new techniques. Not only did I learn how to balance the unique flavors and spices, the teacher also taught us the significance and history behind them. That night I decided I'd host a social dinner for friends and family once I got home, to show off my new skills.

I signed up for tai-chi for the first time ever. I had no idea that it dates back over 700 years – how cool is that? I'd seen tai-chi in movies before, but never knew much about it. Our instructor taught us that performing it is an act of using internal energy — yin and yang — within the movements. It is a form of martial art where you are not supposed to fight or resist force from your opponent; you meet the force with softness instead, following the motion while remaining in physical contact until your opponents tire themselves out.

The Halong Bay cruise is one of those trips that stick with you. To this day I still find myself thinking about the vastness of Sung Sot Cave, the pearls of Tung Sao Pearl Farm, the emerald waters, and those spectacular limestone islands. Each time, I smile and say to myself... "Not bad. Not bad at all."









I will always treasure the huge positive impact that local guides make on a dream vacation. It truly is something to be thankful for. Sith is just one of many cherished memories I have with guides while traveling. I find that it often is

Thanks mainly to the teacher's patience and assistance, we eventually had our very own fully-functioning flute. It proudly sits on a shelf at home, right beside other cool mementos from the various trips I've taken through the years.




