There are three suggested itineraries in Australia, three in New Zealand, and two in Fiji.

Advisors requested high quality vacations to these destinations

"Our travel advisor partners have been asking us to offer Australia, New Zealand, and the South Pacific for some time because these places are very high on most people's travel bucket list. Advisors specifically requested vacations with the same high quality that we provide for Europe and

our other destinations," said Paul Barry, Avanti's CEO. "All three countries are ideal for independent American travelers since English is the predominant language.

"These destinations offer spectacular scenery, abundant opportunities for active travel, wildlife-spotting, fascinating indigenous cultures, and renowned food and wine.

"With flight capacity returning to pre-pandemic levels, the opportunities for direct flights from cities around the US are greatly improving. It is also a region that will give advisors repeat bookings.

Once clients take one independent vacation there, they will want to return, and Avanti's wide array of outstanding experiences ensures that each vacation you create is different from the last," said Barry.

Best times to go to Australia, New Zealand, Fiji

Barry noted that the best time to visit the South Pacific region varies. Australia has a wide range of climates, including tropical, subtropical, desert, and temperate, so travel can take place all year long, depending where clients go. Traveling to New Zealand is best planned for November through March since American winter coincides with New Zealand summer and vice versa. In the tropical paradise of Fiji, April through October is the optimal time, heaviest rains are January through March.

"You can see from the more than 40 South Pacific destinations we have added that we offer not only the most popular, iconic ones, but also smaller, off-the-beaten-path places that other tour operators don't offer, but are extremely worthwhile seeing," pointed out Barry. "In our product selection, we always strive to give advisors the opportunity to help their FIT clients develop an indepth appreciation for the countries that they visit and their cultures, and not just tick the best-known sights off their list. With this launch, we are giving advisors a staggering range of components they can use to build unforgettable vacations."

More than 50 destinations

In Australia, Avanti provides hotels and tours in 25 locations, including: Sydney, with its iconic multi-venue Opera House, widely regarded as an architectural masterpiece; Melbourne with its 150 mile-long scenic Great Ocean Road; Brisbane; Perth; Adelaide, whose Stokes Bay garnered the 2023 Best Australian Beach award; Kangaroo Island, a 45-minute ferry ride from Adelaide and home to koalas, dolphins, sea lions, as well as kangaroos; Cairns and Port Douglas, the two gateway towns to the Great Barrier Reef and Daintree Rainforest, both on UNESCO's list of natural heritage sites; K'gari,

formerly known as **Fraser Island**, the world's largest sand island, where rainforests grow on sand dunes; car-free **Hamilton Island** in the Whitsundays – fringed by the coral reefs and covered in bushland filled with koalas, kangaroos, and kookaburras; **Uluru**, formerly known as Ayers Rock, the massive sandstone monolith that changes colors with the time of day and is sacred to the indigenous people, whose ancestors date back 60,000 years; **Darwin**, the multi-cultural tropical capital of the Northern Territory with a small-town feel, Crocosaurus Cove, and aboriginal art; **Katherine**, famous for its natural hot springs, waterfalls, and 13 stunning gorges; and **Hobart** in the wildlife haven of Tasmania with its unique animal species - wombats, wallabies and pademelons.

In New Zealand, Avanti's 17 locations include four on the North Island: Auckland;
Wellington, home to Te Papa (National Museum exhibiting many Maori artists) and considered New Zealand's culinary capital with more eating and drinking establishments per capita than New York City; Rotorua, center of Maori culture and geothermal activity with bubbling mud pools, spas, age-old forests, pristine lakes, cycling, hiking, fishing, and golf; Hawke's Bay, referred to as the "hidden jewel" of the country, has pastoral scenery, Art Deco buildings, wineries, craft breweries, and the national aquarium with endemic local species of wildlife. On the dramatic mountain- and fjord-filled South Island, Avanti offers hotels and tours in: the two cities of Christchurch and Queenstown; Franz Josef, a small town with natural hot springs near the 7.5 mile long UNESCO World Heritage-designated glacier of the same name (recently renamed to honor the Maori legend about its formation, Ka Roimata o Hine Hukatere); Fox Glacier, near Franz Josef Glacier and surrounded by the mountains of the Southern Alps; Tekapo, a small village on turquoise-colored Lake Tekapo, framed by the Southern Alps and New Zealand's tallest peak, Mount Cook (now called by its Maori name, Aoraki), which sits in the middle of the world's largest Dark Sky Reserve.

In **Fiji**, an archipelago of 333 islands that defines the term "tropical paradise", locations of Avanti's hotels, resorts, and tours include: **Nadi**, on Viti Levu, is Fiji's main island, transit hub and largest town with kayaking, river rafting and zip-lining adventures for the whole family; **Denarau**, a small island west of Nadi known for its high-end resorts, 18-hole golf course, 40 restaurants, and many entertainment options; **Coral Coast** on the southern shore of Viti Levu, has 50 miles of white sand beaches, family-friendly resorts, a vintage sugarcane railway, snorkeling, and scuba diving; the quiet, remote **Mamanuca** Islands are a small archipelago, considered a snorkeler's dream with pristine reefs, tranquil lagoon, and good surf; **Yasawa**, an isolated island with forests, mountains,

caves (*The Blue Lagoon* was filmed here); **Savusavu**, on the island of Vanua Levu (second largest island), is home to waterfalls, hot springs, coconut and sugarcane plantations, pearl farming and chocolate makers that offer tours, and the Namena Marine Reserve, Fiji's premier scuba diving site; **Taveuni**, Fiji's third largest island, has many natural attractions, such as waterfalls, a natural water slide, forests, but is most famous for the Rainbow Reef that runs between Taveuni and Vanua Levu and is one of the South Pacific's top scuba sites; **Suncoast**, an unspoiled, idyllic region on the north side of the main island; two small islands east of Vanua Levu – one, the private island of **Laucala** with luxury resorts (Oprah stayed there) and to the west, **Wakaya** with dense forests, beautiful beaches, surrounded by a protected marine area filled with coral reefs and marine life; **Suva**, the capital of Fiji is where clients can learn about the history of the island nation (the Fiji Museum) and how modern Fijians live, including what the eat – at the two-story municipal market; **Pacific Harbor** to the west of Suva is the "adventure capital" of Fiji, where activities include *diving with sharks*, , zip-lining, jet-boating, whitewater rafting, river tubing, surfing, and *watching native fire-walkers*.
