DAY 1 EDINBURGH, SCOTLAND MEALS: Dinner

Arrive at Edinburgh Airport and head into the city, enjoying a panoramic tour enroute. Relax and unwind at the hotel before meeting up for a welcome dinner.

OVERNIGHT: Hampton by Hilton Edinburgh West End or similar

DAY 2 EDINBURGH, SCOTLAND MEALS: Breakfast

Get an in-depth look into this historic city on a half-day walking tour along Royal Mile, Old Town, and Grassmarket, stealing views of Edinburgh Castle. After dark, experience the awe-striking Military Tattoo, a famed annual display of musicians and dancers showcasing their talents with the castle as a backdrop.

OVERNIGHT: Hampton by Hilton Edinburgh West End or similar

DAY 3 TRAVEL TO AVIEMORE, SCOTLAND MEALS: All

Head to Aviemore, a town nestled within Cairngorms National Park, traversing the Scottish countryside along the way. Stop at a specialty patchwork and quilt shop in the heart of Perth, then savor lunch at Blair Castle and learn about its 700 years of history. Settle into Aviemore and enjoy dinner at the hotel.

OVERNIGHT: Coylumbridge Aviemore Hotel or similar

DAY 4 AVIEMORE, SCOTLAND MEALS: Breakfast, Dinner

Delve deep into the Scottish Highlands and explore the beauty of Inverness. Cruise atop the waters of the famed Scottish waterway, keeping an eye out for the Loch Ness Monster! Stop at a local quilt shop, visit the ruins of Urquhart, and soak up the surrounding scenery.

OVERNIGHT: Coylumbridge Aviemore Hotel or similar

DAY 5 AVIEMORE, SCOTLAND MEALS: Breakfast, Dinner

Journey to the Knockando Woolmill and dive into the craft of carding, spinning, and weaving while unveiling the history of the property, dating back to 1784. Then explore a traditional farm, watching as a Shepard and his team of sheepdogs guide and maneuver herds of livestock.

OVERNIGHT: Coylumbridge Aviemore Hotel or similar

DAY 6 TRAVEL TO FORT WILLIAM, SCOTLAND MEALS: Breakfast, Dinner

Pack up and head to Fort William, known for its stunning fortress and scenery of Ben Nevis, the highest mountain of the UK. Stop at a whiskey distillery for a tour and tasting, and pass by Glenfinnan Viaduct, recognizable from Harry Potter.

OVERNIGHT: Bridge of Orchy or similar

DAY 7 FORT WILLIAM, SCOTLAND MEALS: Breakfast, Dinner

Travel up to the Isle of Skye, an island beloved for its tranquility and scenery. Stop at Eilean Donan, an iconic image of Scotland, then explore the isle's Dunvegan Castle and Gardens, the country's oldest inhabited castle. Enjoy scenery along the way before spending a leisurely evening back at Fort William.

OVERNIGHT: Bridge of Orchy or similar

DAY 8 TRAVEL TO EDINBURGH, SCOTLAND MEALS: Breakfast, Dinner

Pass back through the Highlands on the way to a final night in Edinburgh. Along the way, enter Stirling Castle, home to many royals including Mary Queen of Scots. Back in the city, delight in a final farewell dinner with the group.

OVERNIGHT: Moxy Edinburgh Airport Hotel or similar

After one last breakfast at the hotel, head out to the airport.
